Hosts informal monthly discussions on topics related to atheism, such as politics, church/state separation, religions, skepticism, and science.

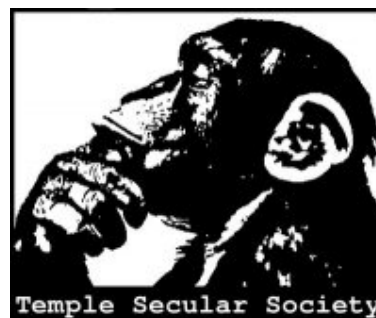
